**Bulldog Bolt T-Shirt Sign Up**

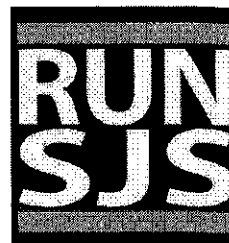
