



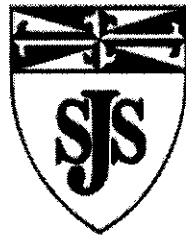

*Do Not Park on the side of the building and walk around.

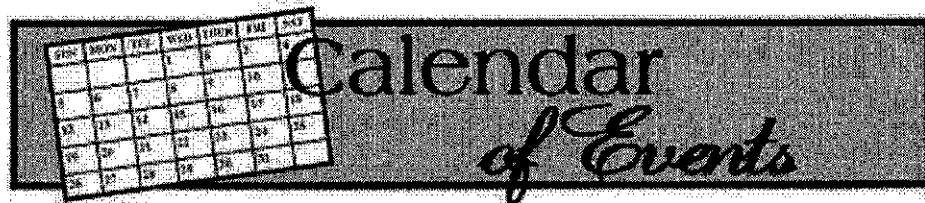
*Do Not Park and walk under the Gym Overpass.

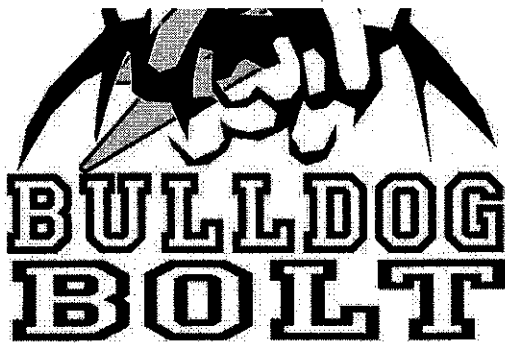

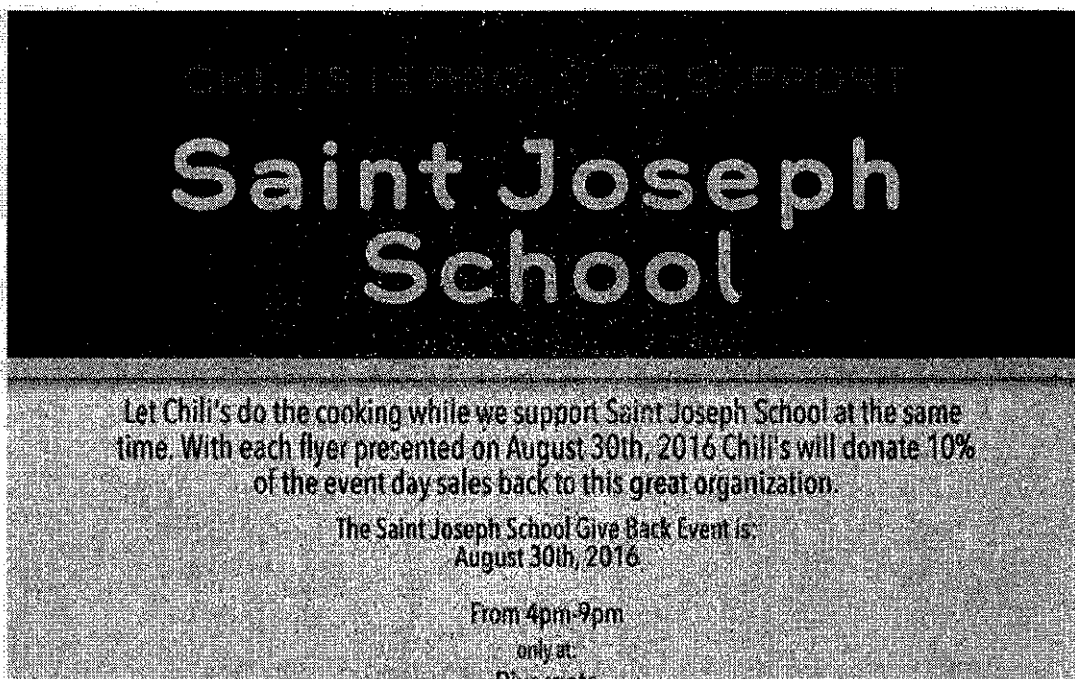
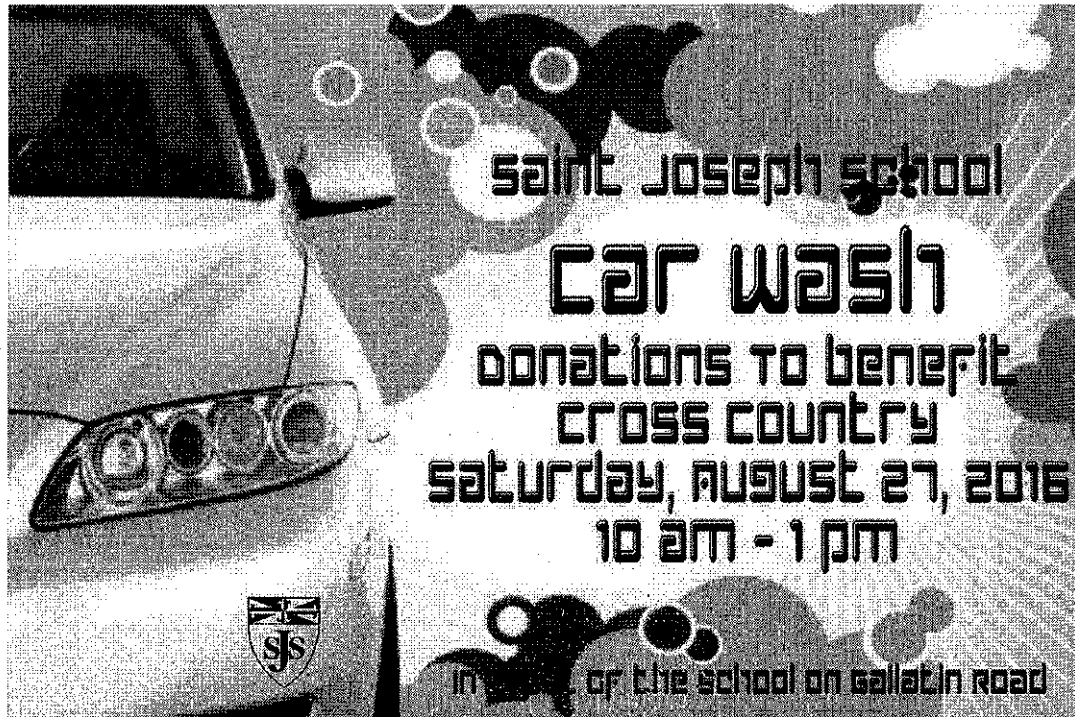
