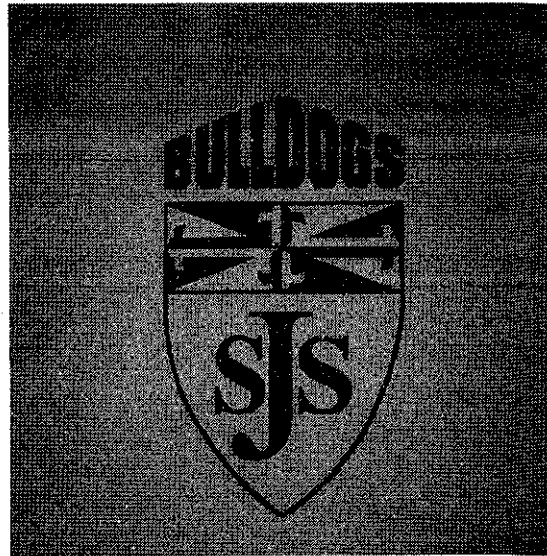
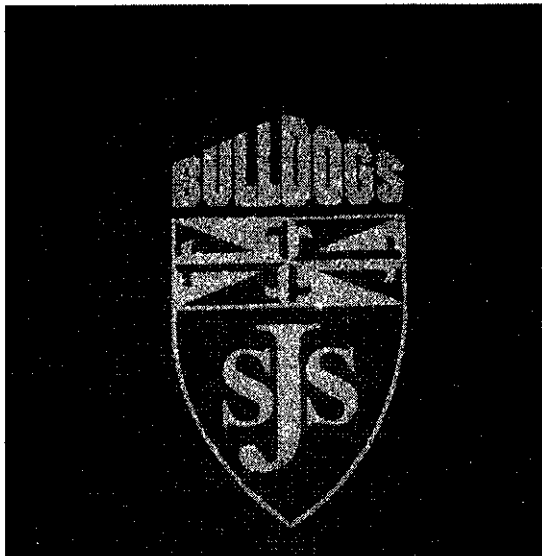
SJS Bulldog Golf Classic



Dust off your clubs and get ready for the Annual Bulldog Golf Classic. This year's event will take place at Country

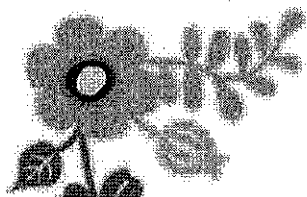
