Dear Sixth Grade Parents,

I would like to inform you that I will be teaching the Safe@Last curriculum to the sixth graders. Topics we will cover include: respect (recognizing the rights and individual differences of others and treating them as you would like to be treated); Internet safety; boundaries; safe people who become unsafe people; teasing; harassing and unsafe touching. Please review with your child what he/she is learning about safety as this information could save a child's life or keep a child safe from harm.

The program we are using was developed by the Sexual Assault Center in Nashville and this program is mandated as part of the diocese curriculum. I encourage each of you to reinforce this knowledge at home. Our goal is to equip the children with the knowledge they will need should they find themselves in an unsafe situation.
